# Propane

The kids are almost out of school and by time you read this Memorial Day and the beginning of summer will be just around the corner, but the Energy Department at West Central FS is preparing and planning for winter.

We will be starting Summer Fill LP program the beginning of June and you will have the option to defer this until your September statement.

We are also offering our standard payment & contracting programs.

Here is a brief description of the programs for you

**Budget Billing** – With this contract we offer the cost of your estimated usage to be spread out over an 11 month period starting in July 2018 and ending in May 2019. If the gallons estimated are exceeded during your heating season, the remaining balance will be due by June 25, 2019 in order to continue with the program the next year. If payments are not received on a monthly basis, finance charges will be assessed and the contract will be terminated with all future deliveries subject to normal credit terms. This program is the most widely used by our home heat customer as it is easily implemented into your monthly budget.

**Firm Price** – With this contract the buyer agrees to purchase estimated gallons during a specified time period at a listed price per gallon with payment due the following month. All deliveries are subject to normal credit terms.

**Prepay** – With this contract the buyer agrees to a one-time payment of the amount of their estimated usage. The prepay amount is due at the time of contract signing.


I hope our explanation of the different contract options allows you to pick one that best suits your needs.

We feel Budget Billing allows the convenience of a payment you can budget whereas you have opportunity to obtain a price advantage by prepaying.

At West Central FS we work very hard to give you options to manage your LP payments, so this fall and winter sitting in front of your gas fireplace, or preparing a home cooked meal from your gas stove, or even a nice long warm shower with water from your gas water heater is a pleasure and not a burden.

## Washing Pesticide-Soiled Clothing

(University of Illinois Extension)

- Discard clothing containing concentrated pesticides.
- All clothing worn while handling or applying concentrated or diluted pesticides is contaminated.
- Keep contaminated clothing separate from other laundry.
- Handle all contaminated clothing with gloves.
- Wash clothing daily soon after use, starch clothing.
- Use warm or hot water wash, at least two cold water rinses.
- Use heavy-duty laundry detergent.
- Use longest wash cycle, at least 10-12 minutes.
- Multiple launderings removes more of the pesticide residue from clothing.
- After washing is complete, clean washer by running machine through a complete cycle with detergent and hot water but without clothing.
